<u>8/7 BoG Aug.15:</u> Academic reforms of M.Tech course under TEQIP-II for the academic year 2015-16.

Periodical academic reforms are the regular feature of Institute of Science and Technology to incorporate recent developments in the syllabus with the valuable inputs from experts invited from various industries and academic Institutes under the guidance of BoS. In the process, syllabus has been revised for the academic year 2014-15. Now, Board of Studies of all the centres are strongly recommending to implement Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), a curricular reform to enable the students to have uniform credit system as well as to get the benefit of several electives offered by all the centres of IST, from the academic year 2015-16. CBCS is also recommended by UGC & JNT University Hyderabad. In order to implement CBCS system, BoS meetings at different centres should be conducted for finalization of syllabi. It is proposed to meet this expenditure from TEQIP-II unds as per norms under reforms under Student Assistantship head of account. The total expenditure for the implementation of CBCS system is around Rs.10,02,000/-. The vision of the expenditure is given below.

Institute of Science and Technology (INTUH, New building was constructed in the TEQIP Phase-I with two floors (Ground and Fhot). Later with the University funds Third and Fourth floors were constructed. In the design, provision has been made for two lifts adjacent to the staircase. Class rooms and labs have been allocated for various courses of IST. It is becoming difficult for the faculty, staff and students to climb number of times up to fourth floors. The approximate cost of the each lift is around Rs.10,00,000/- under Civil works through PMSS.

The item may be ansigred and approval of BoG.

19/7 BoG regular: Consideration and approval for providing safe drinking water to both new and old buildings of IST through RO system under civil works category of TEQIR-1.

At present we are purchasing drinking water from the University RO system through 25 liters cans. They are not regular, not supplying in time and sometimes it is not sufficient, with this effect centres are facing difficult for getting the safe drinking water at both new and old IST buildings.

It is proposed to have a separate RO system, plumbing network with outlets at different floors, labs and staff rooms at both the IST buildings under TEQIP of Civil works through PMSS. The approximate cost of the each system is around Rs.12,00,000/-.
