MINUTES

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<u>01/14 BoG</u> <u>Jun, 17</u>: Minutes of Meeting of 13thBoG meeting held on 7th April, 2017 – for information.

The minutes of the 13th BoG meeting has been circulated to the Honorable Chairman and all the BoG members through email on 20th April, 2017 for suggestions and approval. Further, requested all the members to send their suggestions for incorporation in the document on or before 25th April 2017. All the suggestions made by the BoG members were incorporated. The final minutes were uploaded in the Institute website www.istjntuh.ac.in.

Minutes of the 13th BoG are here by confirmed by the Governing Body.

02/14 BoG_ Jun, 17: Funds status of TEQIP-II and its activities – for information.

TEQIP-II of JNTUH IST has been allotted Rs. 12.5 Crores under Subcomponent 1.2. An amount of Rs. 10.5 Crores has been received and remaining amount of Rs. 2.0 Crores has to be released under TEQIP-II. Amount from Non performing Institutions is not yet released. The pool of money may be given to the performing Institutions. In this process we may also get some amount from the State government. The interest acquired under TEQIP-II is Rs. 29,86,617/- (Rupees Twenty Nine Lakhs Eighty Six Thousand Six Hundred & Seventeen Only).

Honorable chairman and members of BoG discussed about the possibility of the release of funds from Non- performing Institutions through State government. They also discussed that funds should be accepted from the state government, if they allow the expenditure from the date of receiving the amount

<u>03/14 BoG Jun, 17</u>: Expenditure incurred till date in TEQIP-II – for Ratification.

Member secretary explained the expenditure head wise incurred in the project. The total expenditure since the inception of the TEQIP-II project to 31st March 2017 is 1067.57 Lakhs only.

Honorable chairman and members of BoG have ratified the expenditure statement.

04/14 BoG_ Jun, 17: Common Facilities planned under TEQIP-II – for ratification

Common facilities of Audio facilities at Seminar hall, LED projector and Computers along with UPS are necessary for the Upgradation of the seminar hall and the classrooms of IST respectively.

Honorable chairman and members of BoG also discussed about the Profile sheet roofing at 4th Floor, New IST building. As the faculty did not respond within the time period given, the civil works for the individual departments cannot be initiated now.

Honorable chairman and members of BoG ratified the action taken by the Director, IST.

<u>05/14 BoG Jun, 17</u>: Consideration and approval for increase in the Imprest amount to the TEQIP-III Coordinator

Honorable chairman and members of BoG approved the increased Imprest amount of Rs.15,000/- per month to TEQIP-III coordinator including the mobile bill.

<u>06/14 BoG Jun, 17</u>: Consideration and approval of the Honorarium to the Director, Coordinator and the Nodal officers under TEQIP-III

For the smooth functioning of TEQIP-III, it is proposed to have a committee with Director, Coordinator and Nodal Officers. As practiced and implemented in TEQIP-II, monthly Honorarium may be given to all the committee members in TEQIP-III also. This may be followed until any new guidelines for TEQIP-III are received from the NPIU / SPFU. The approved monthly honorarium is given in the table below.

Further, members of BoG also felt that Nodal officers may be limited to one officer under each head, as one officer will have full knowledge under that head and will be responsible to the works allotted. However, the decision of the number of Nodal officers is final as per the decision of the Director based on the responsibilities and efficiency.

Honorable Chairman and members of BoG approved the increase in honorarium, until new guidelines are received from NPIU/SPFU for TEQIP-III.

<u>07/14 BoG_ Jun, 17:</u> Annulling the TEQIP-II officers– for information

As TEQIP-II ended by 31st March 2017, automatically the TEQIP-II committee is considered as null and void with effective from 31st March 2017.

Honorable chairman and members of BoG resolved to issue Thanks letter to all the TEQIP-II officers by 31st July 2017. Further, chairman of BoG directed Director, IST to issue thanks letter to all the nodal officers of TEQIP-II committee

Dr.M.V.S.S.Giridhar, Head & Associate Professor, Centre for Water Resources (CWR), IST, JNTUH is appointed as TEQIP-III coordinator.

Honorable chairman and members of BoG approved the same.

09/14 BoG_ Jun, 17: Appointment of staff for TEQIP-III office – for Approval

It is resolved to appoint the below staff for smooth function of TEQIP phase III project at IST, JNTUH. Salary for the TEQIP Phase III period to the below staff may be fixed as any graduate will be given Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) per month and any Post graduate will be given Rs. 17,500/- (Rupees Seventeen Thousand & five Hundred Only) per month. Attender will be given Rs.12,000/- (Rupees Twelve Thousand Only) per month as per the Telangana State government rules in vogue.

11/14 BoG_ Jun, 17: Conduct of BoS meetings at different centres of IST – for approval

Honorable chairman and members of BoG approved the conduct of the BoS meetings for the academic year 2017-18 from the TEQIP-III funds for all the eligible centres of IST.

<u>12/14 BoG Jun, 17</u>: Revised Honorarium for the members attending the BoG Meeting – for Approval

Honorable chairman and members of BoG discussed and approved the revised Honorarium as Rs.4,000/- (Rupees Four Thousand Only) and will be implemented from the next BoG and continued till any new guidelines are received from NPIU/SPFU.

13/14 BoG_Jun, 17: TEQIP-III heads of account – for Information

Member Secretary explained to Honorable chairman and members of BoG that 3 heads of account are allocated under sub component 1.3. A budget of Rs. 7.0 Crores has been allotted to JNTUH IST and the following heads are under SC 1.3.

Procurement of goods
 Academic processes
 Operating costs
 3.5 Crores
 2.8 Crores
 0.7 Crores

Under the head of Procurement of goods 50% of PLA is allocated, if the procurement of goods is concentrated in the early quarters of the project and major amount can be utilized. Any Institute utilizing 50 % of the allocated amount at the initial stage of the project can claim for the additional funds.

Members also felt that Research and Development and Industry Institute Interaction should be concentrated more as JNTUH IST is known for R&D.

<u>14/14 BoG_ Jun, 17</u>: Consideration & approval for the purchase of one lift under TEQIP-III

In the design of the new IST building provision for two lifts are given and the approximate cost of each lift is around Rs.22,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Two Lakhs Only).

Honorable chairman and members of BoG approved the purchase of one lift with the following conditions.

- 1. Machinery used for lift may be purchased under the category of the Equipments
- 2. All other Civil works related to the lift may be booked under the category of the Civil works
- 3. This action may be initiated after the TEQIP-III initiation

This may be subjected to the approval from the NPIU.

Honorable chairman and members of BoG considered and approved the purchase of one lift under TEQIP-III.

<u>15/14 BoG_ Jun, 17</u>: To discuss and finalize the upper limit of expenditure for the publication of research papers – for approval

Faculty can publish unlimited number of publications under the project. The maximum amount allocated is Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) per publication. The same will be applicable to the Eligible students & Research Scholars under TEQIP-III. Any extra amount should be bear by the faculty/ scholar/ student only. Only SCI or UGC approved journals are considered.

Honourable Chairman and members of BoG discussed and approved the same.
