MINUTES OF THE 21st BOG MEETING

The 21st BoG meeting of IST, JNTUH was convened in the Meeting Hall of the Director, Institute of Science and Technology (IST), JNTUH, Hyderabad at 11a.m, on Saturday 3rd August, 2019. The meeting of the Board of Governors was chaired by Prof. P.Jaya Prakash Rao and welcomed all the BoG members to the 21st BoG Meeting. The Chairman BoG, had asked Prof. B.Venkateswara Rao, Director, IST, JNTUH to present the detailed agenda of the meeting for discussion.

Prof. B.Venkateswara Rao, Director, IST, JNTUH extended a hearty welcome to The Chairperson, Members of the BoG and Special Invitees. Director made a presentation on significant activities taken up and achievements of IST to the honorable members of the BoG, since last meeting i.e. May to August 2019. Details of action taken report was presented by the Director IST to the members of the BoG. With the Chairperson's consent, agenda of the meeting was placed for consideration, discussion and for relevant ratifications in detail.

In the opening remarks, Hon'ble Chairperson, congratulated the IST for being shortlisted as one of the High Performing Institution and for qualifying for additional grants from NPIU. Chairperson appreciated the efforts by the Director IST towards securing UGC autonomous status and completion of 2nd Performance auditing. He had summarized the observations made by the performance auditor to the Members of the Governing Body and suggested that IST has to maintain alumni record regularly and do the tracer studies of the passed-out students, and improve the employability opportunities. Chairperson advised to consolidate all the academic activities of IST, their outcome i.e in terms of publications, patents, curriculum changes and present the status of expenditure under academic processes.

Prof.Nagabhushana Rao, Mentor IST, suggested that the Ph.D Scholars may be advised to appear for other competitive exams for research scholarships in view of the TEQIP III project time period is ending by September 2020 to ensure smooth continuation and progress of the research activity. The Director is advised to approach assistance from the Industry partners to institute research assistanceship to the scholars who will not be receiving the fellowship after the project period. Dr.Shiv Kumaran and Dr.Rakesh Bandichhor , members of the Governing body felt that industry representatives in the IST- Industry Consultation Committee may be approached for hand holding to all the Ph.D scholars till they complete PhD.

Action taken report was presented to the Hon.'ble members, by the Director, IST. During his presentation, he has highlighted about the significant achievements of IST such as UGC autonomous status to IST and recognition to IST as high performing institute and shortlisted for additional grants from NPIU. After detailed discussion and exchange of opinions, the detailed head wise agenda was presented by the Director IST. The minutes of the meeting as per the agenda items is as given below. :

The Director, IST has summarized the activities and action taken after the 20th BoG meeting.

Action taken report is as follows:

Autonomous Status: The UGC expert team has visited IST, JNTUH during 12-13 June, 2019 for extension of Autonomous status to the IST. Later the autonomous status was accorded to JNTUH Institute of Science and Technology by UGC for a period of 5 years w.e.f 2019-2020 to 2023-2024 vide their letter No.F.22-1/2017(AC) dated 02 July, 2019.

Procurement of Goods:

Out of the total allocated budget of Rs. 350 lakhs, an amount of Rs. 3,26,82,778/- has been incurred towards procurement of goods / items under the head of Procurement. The expenditure in pipeline is Rs. 14,07,717/-. Balance amount is Rs.9,09,505/- which will be incurred towards Goods / civil works.

Faculty members, technical staff and students of respective centers of the IST have organized & participated in number of activities with the support of TEQIP III project, during May-July, 2019.

During 17th BoG the budget for Academic Process under TEQIP-III is allocated and till now the incurred expenditure is **Rs. 1,02,26,474/-** from 1 Apr-2017 to 31 July- 2019 under various heads.

❖ **Incremental Operating Cost:**

- Under this head, Internal and statutory Auditing was carried out for TEQIP-III project on 9-10 May, 2019 for the years 2018-19 the internal and statutory audit report is without any objections.

The BoG has approved the above expenditure.

04/21 BoG_Aug-19	To consider and approve the sanction of seed grant for research to the contract faculty of IST, JNTUH.
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Dr.Prakash Kuniyal, Academic Specialist & Admin., NPIU has visited IST, JNTUH on 18thJuly, 2019 to review the progress of TEQIP expenditure. During his visit it has been remarked that though IST is doing well in all fronts, the expenditure in the academic processes is still 36.5% even after the project has crossed half way mark. Hence in the presence of SPIU representatives it has been advised to extend the seed grant facility to the contract faculty also. He cited the example of recent grants for research projects sanctioned to the temporary faculty appointed by NPIU to various TEQIP-III institutions.

Hence, it is proposed to extend the existing facility of sanctioning seed grant to contract faculty for research, with a condition that one of the regular faculty should act as a Co-PI and responsible for all administrative purposes.

The BoG has approved the same with the following conditions.

- It is mandatory to have one regular faculty member as Co-PI for the research proposal. If required, it is advised to act as Co PI for more than one project.
- Members of the BoG suggested to review the proposals thoroughly including the financial matters.
- Proposals need to be scrutinized by the departmental research committee, and recommendations of the DRC are to be approved by the Subcommittee members consisting of Internal BoG members for further approval of the project.
- Co-PI is responsible for all **administrative and financial matters** of the project and project outcome.

05/21 BoG_Aug-19	To consider and approve the enhancement of Experimental charges from Rs.10,000/- to Rs.20,000/- for M.Tech Project students.
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Currently the IST is sanctioning Rs.10,000/- to M.Tech students towards meeting the experimental charges such as purchase of chemicals, data, field work expenses etc., during their M.Tech project period. However they are representing that for some of the students, the chemicals utilized are costly and fieldwork by vehicle engaged is also expensive, hence they are requesting to enhance the grant from Rs.10,000/- to Rs.20,000/-.

This is submitted for consideration and approval of the BoG.

The BoG approved the enhancement from Rs.10000 to a Maximum of Rs.20000.The change comes into effect from August 2019.

The BoG has approved all the above programs and advised the organizers of the 3rd program to involve not only the HR Managers and captains of the Industry but also the academicians to have a one to one discussion with relevant industry to improve the employability of the graduates.

To consider and approve the Research Assistantship enhancement from Rs.18000/- to Rs.25000/-under Research Assistantship of TEQIP-III Grants.

It is to inform to the honorable members of the BoG that all the national level scholarships for the JRF are in the order of Rs.32,500/- per month excluding HRA. The present Assistantship for the TEQIP-III Research Scholars is only Rs.18000/- per month which was sanctioned during TEQIP-II period. Therefore there is a need to enhance the research assistantship as per the request of the TEQIP-III scholars. The matter has been placed before 20th BoG and discussed at length. Finally it was suggested to the director to obtain a consensus amongst the TEQIP-III funded institutes of JNTUH campus to achieve the uniformity of TEQIP-III scholarships. Accordingly the director has written a letter to the JNTUH College of engineering. They replied that they have already enhanced scholarship to Rs.25000/-. Hence it is proposed to enhance the research assistantship of Ph.D scholars under TEQIP-III from Rs.18000/- to Rs.25000/-.

The BoG has approved the same with effect from August 2019 and assistantship lasts till the end of TEQIP-III Project period.

To consider and approve the Extension of Research Assistantship to the full time scholars with Science background but working in the areas of Technology and Engineering Problems.

It is to submit to honorable members of BoG that IST is offering postgraduate programs not only in engineering but also in science. All the Ph.D programs are taken up in the problems of applied science and technologies. For Ph.D programs of IST, scholars from both science and engineering backgrounds are joining and working in the areas of emerging technologies. So far we have considered M.Tech graduates only for research assistantship of TEQIP-III. It is proposed to consider M.Sc graduates also for awarding research assistantship for TEQIP-III as both of them are getting Ph.D degrees under the same faculty.

The BoG has approved the same and suggested to follow the earlier procedure of selection in awarding the scholarship.
